Averlea is a modern & friendly place, it was purpose built to a very high standard of comfort and convenience and it is registered for fourteen residents.

Residents rooms are all single with the exception of one which is a double to accommodate a couple, also one of the single rooms has an en-suite w/c. Good food is offered and special diets can be catered for. There is a TV lounge, and a quiet room where residents are encouraged to pursue their hobbies & interests. Most afternoons there are activities such as bingo, which both entertains and stimulates the mind. For those interested there is a service performed every other week by a local preacher.
